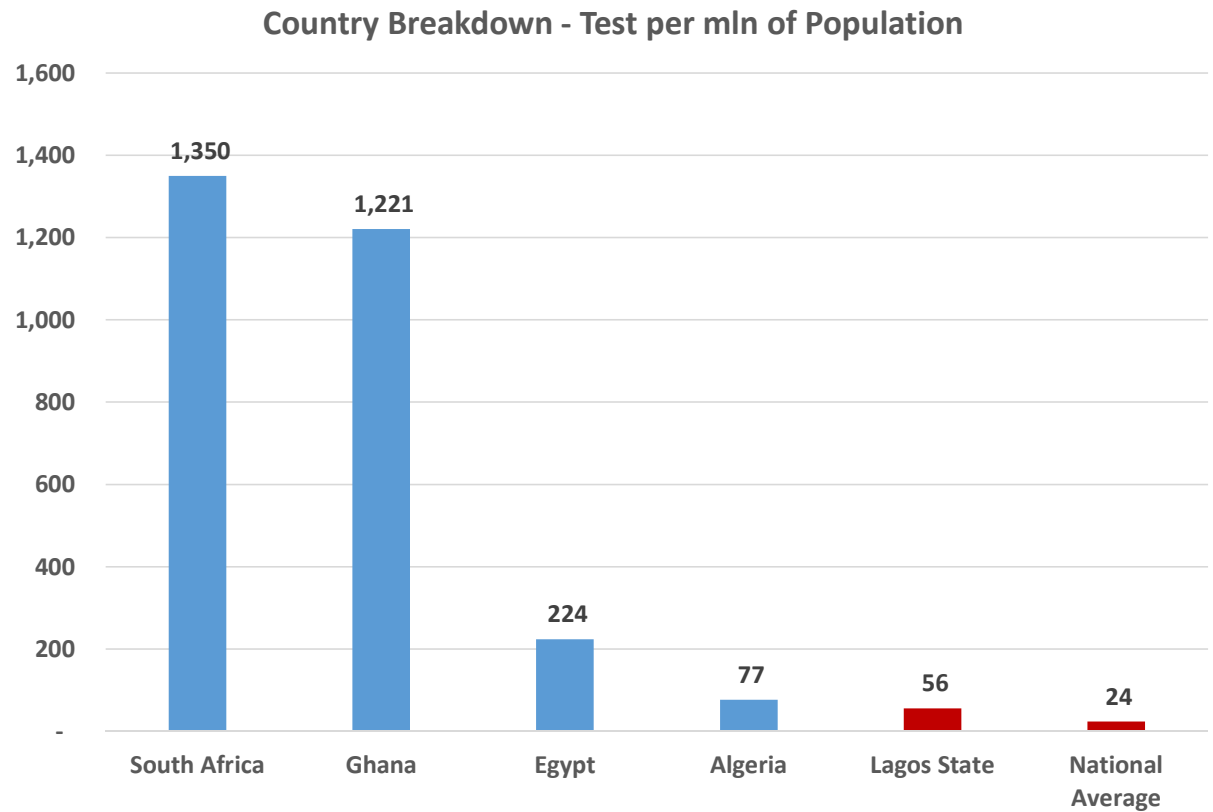

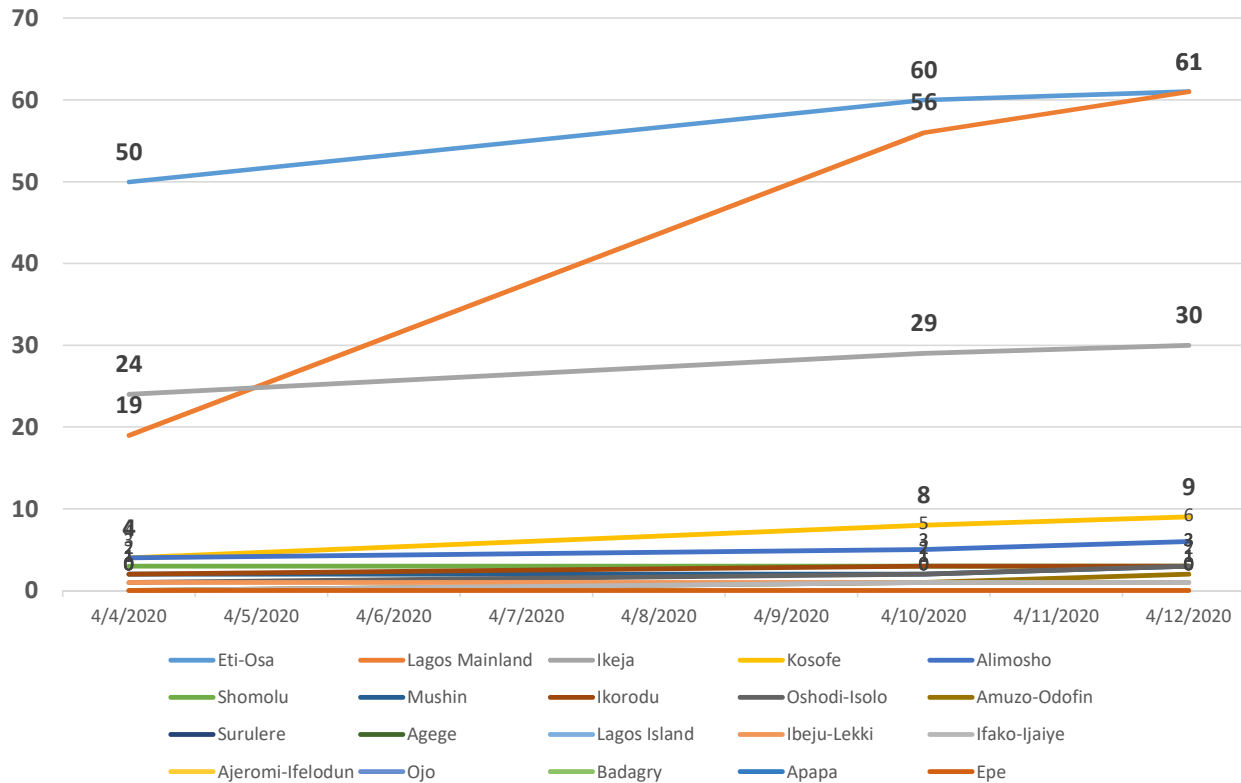

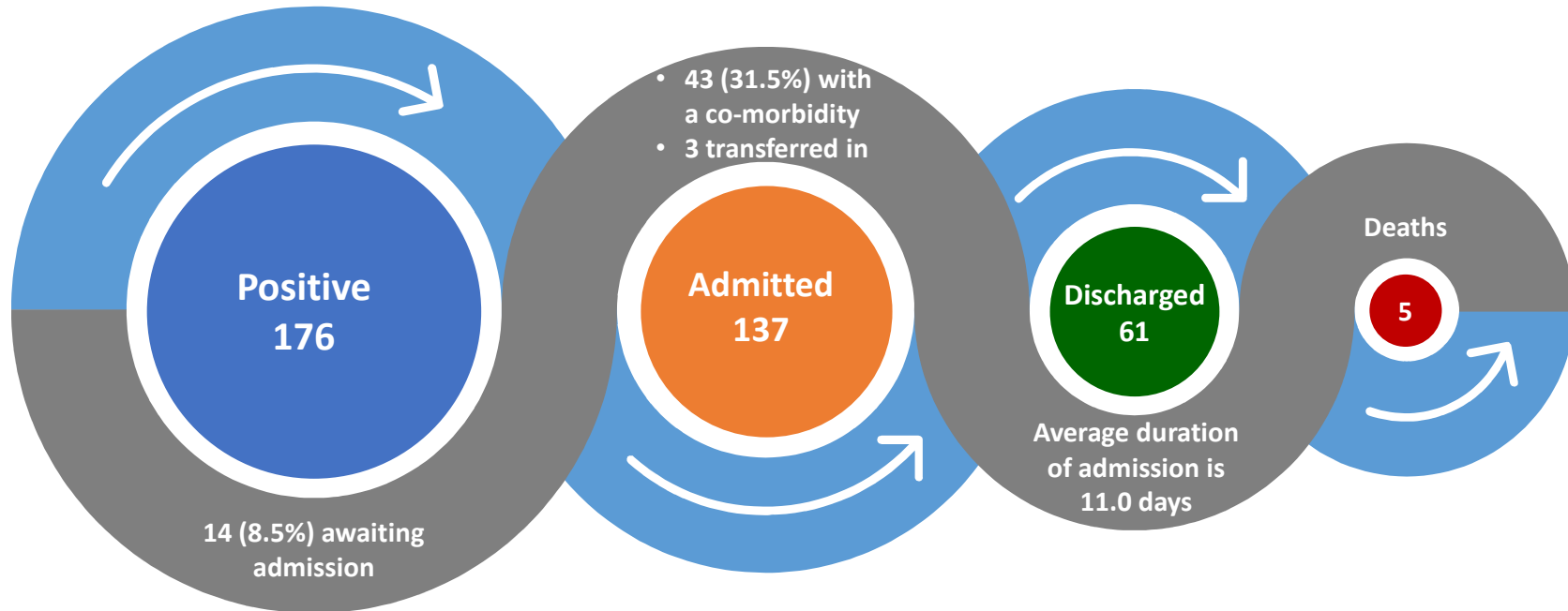
# Breakdown of Tests by Local Government Area

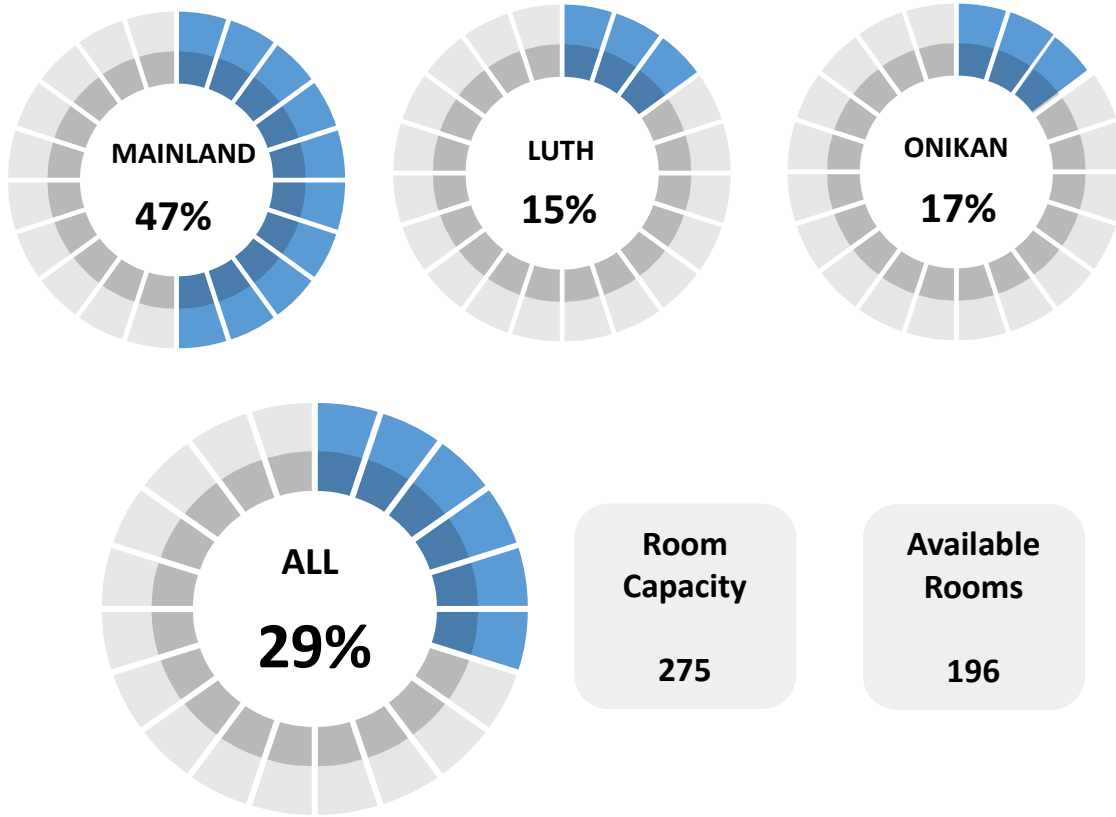

- Severe - 4%



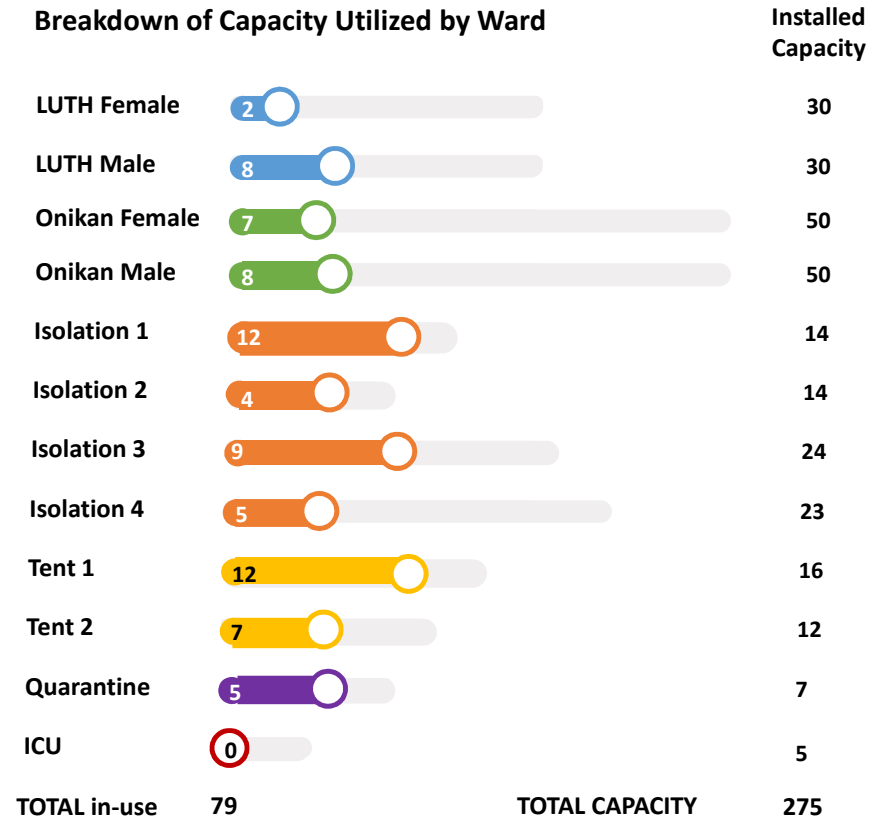
# Bed Capacity Utilization

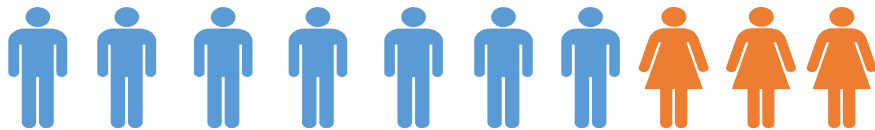
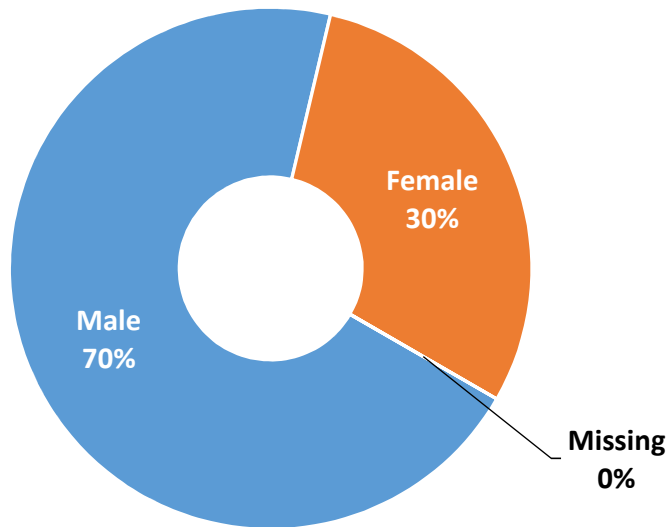
## Breakdown of Capacity Utilized by Ward



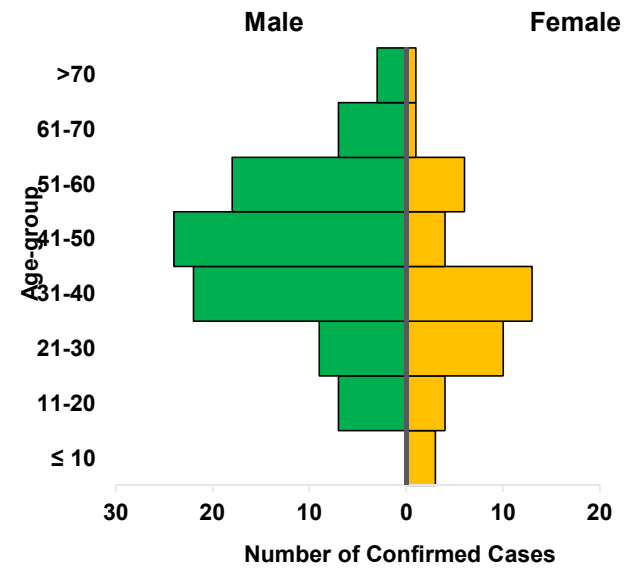

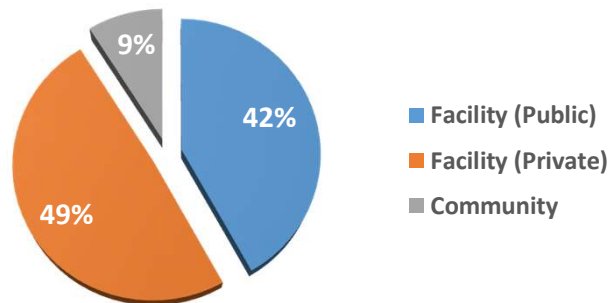
